## Appendix III - Filet Lace Stitch Variations

The samples below were knitted in Patons Cotton DK on 3.75mm needles. They are straight off the needles and have not been washed or blocked. The garter stitch edging limits how far the samples will stretch in length but if they are pulled sideways, the grid opens up considerably.



Sample 1: The most robust - the 3 stitches were slipped purlwise in the first pattern row and (k1, ktbl, p1), in the second row.



Sample 2: The stitches were slipped purlwise in the first eyelet pattern row and (k1, k1, p1), in the second row.



Sample 3: The stitches were slipped knitwise in the first pattern row and (k1, ktbl, p1), in the second row.



Sample 4: - The loosest -the stitches were slipped knitwise in the first pattern row and (k1, k1, p1), in the second.
