## Lucia & Will - Additional Ideas and Notes

Here are some photos and ideas of hats knitted using the Lucia & Will Hat Pattern. These ideas are only a guide as quantities will vary due to the elasticity of different yarns - stretchy yarns or yarns with a high wool content, tend to take up more  $\cdot$  I calculated 2.5m per knitted row at the main part of the hat before decreases.

Stripe 1 of a large size hat (5 rows) used no more than 12.5m·

Stripe 2 of a large size hat (9rows) used no more than 22.5m.

All photographs are of a large size hat, worn on a 57cm/22.5inch head, unless otherwise stated.



This hat was knitted using 42g/120m Wendy Mode DK (50% merino, 50% acrylic)



This hat was knitted using 42g/93m of black Wendy Merino DK and:

Stripe 1: SMC Merino DK 5g/12.5m

Stripe 3: Sublime Merino DK 5g/12m

Stripe 5: Katia Artist DK 4g/10m

Stripe 7: Sirdar Escape DK 4g/9m

Stripe 9: Katia Artist DK 3g/7.5m

Stripe 11: Sublime Merino DK 1g/2.5m



King Cole Baby Alpaca DK 40g/80m Malabrigo Silky Merino DK 15g/40m



A break from the norm, this hat was knitted using two strands of 4-ply yarn, used double throughout. 48g of Denis Brunton Magicolour (now discontinued).



This hat weighed in at a total of 60g, which comprised 45g of red Superwash 100% wool DK alongside 15g of SMC Merino DK stripes in black/red marl, pink and purple



Similar to the hat above, this hat was knitted with 45g Superwash 100% wool DK in cream and pale grey, alongside 15g of assorted stripes of acrylic yarn of unknown brand·



The most yarn hungry hat of all, this one used up 66g/145m of Sirdar Escape DK·



Another hungry hat, this is a medium size hat which used 59g/136m of Rowan Designer DK-1005 wool·
